Khufu

- ★ Ruled during the old Kingdom
 - o 2551 to 2528 B.C.E.
- ★ Had the Great Pyramid of Giza built
 - One of the wonders of the world today
- ★ Helped establish Pharaohs as a central authority.
 - Declared himself a god and kept control over everything to keep a strong rule over the people,



Senusret I

- ★ Ruled during the Middle Kingdom
 - o 1971 to 1926 B.C.E.
- ★ Egypt was stable and unified during this time
- ★ Art, Literature and Architecture flourished during his time as leader
 - Built the White Chapel (made of alabaster)
 - Some of the greatest works of Literature were during is reign. ("The Story of Sinuhu)



Queen Hatshepsut

- ★ Ruled during the New Kingdom
 - o 1473-1458 BC
- ★ Encouraged trade with other countries
- ★ Ruled for the appointed Pharaoh (Thutmose III) because he was too young at the time to rule
 - Thutmose III was the son of another one of Thutmose II's wives (she was married to Thutmose II)
 - Declared herself Pharaoh after acting leadership for a few years - this was unusual for this time
- ★ Temple at Deir-el-Bahri was built on her behalf



King Tut (Tutankhaten)

- ★ Ruled during the New Kingdom
 - o 1332 to 1323 B.C.E.
- ★ His tomb eluded grave robbers allowing archaeologists to study his tomb
 - His Mummy was placed in a coffin made of solid gold.
- ★ He was only 10 years old when he took power.



Ramses II

- * Ruled during the New Kingdom
 - o 1290 to 1224 B.C.E.
- * Known for his architecture
 - Two most notable are: the Ramesseum and the temples of Abu Simbel
- * Known for his military strength
- ★ Had the people believe he was also a god
 - This helped ease access for his son to rule next after him
- ★ He was buried in the Valley of Kings
